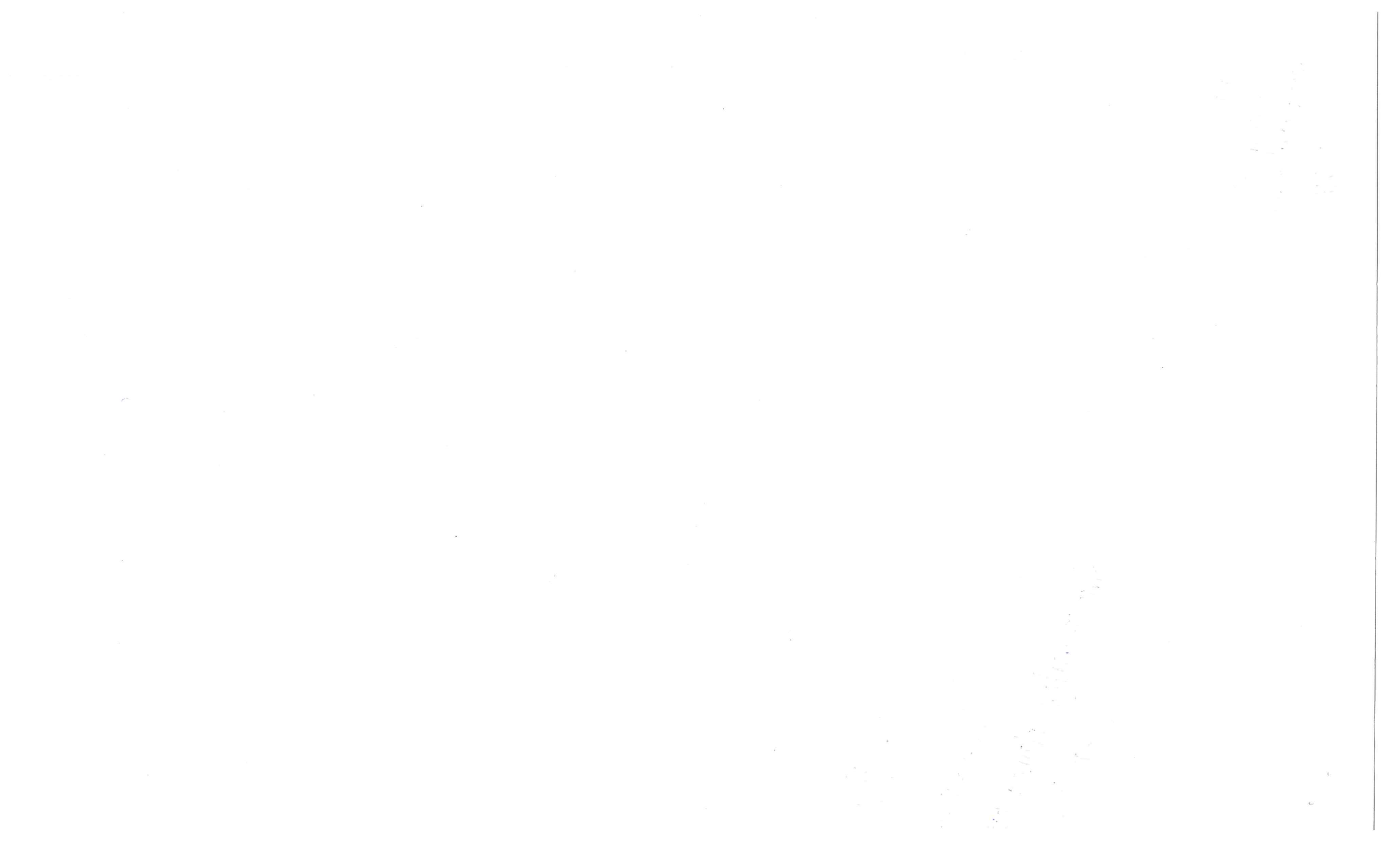

While developing the Time Table, a period is shown for Digital Class for every subject (A model Time Table and Schedule will be communicated by Director, SIET from time to time).

Utilization of Optional Holidays (OH) to the Teachers rather than Institutions :- It is decided that, the existing practice of OH to the Schools needs to be changed and the teachers will avail OH rather than whole school in case of High Schools only. However, the availment of OH shall be limited to 30% of the teachers on any given OH. The discretion of sanctioning 30% OH to the teachers will be with the Head Masters / Principals concerned. For the Primary Schools and Upper Primary Schools the existing system shall continue.
